This was how he made money to care for and feed his large family. He developed health problems with his stomach and had to have an operation. It was very difficult for the family as they had no money for the expensive operation. With the help of other churches in the area and the missionary the funds were raised and he had surgery. He begin to recover right away and was able to go back to work at his repair shop and serve as a very faithful pastor.

In March of 2002 he became sick again, and once again was taken to the hospital. They found that he had stomach cancer and he only lived a few weeks and died on April 7, 2002. Thus, leaving his family with just a very small plot and a three room house and no income of any kind.

His wife, Beatrice sells vegetables in the marketplace and tried to feed the children but it is very hard for her to make enough just to feed the children. The children have no clothes to wear that are in good condition. They have a problem with going to school since they can't even pay their book fees and when they reach High School they are sent away because their mother can not pay for them to be educated above 8th grade.

Beatrice has remained faithful to the Lord and tries very hard to educate and meet the needs of her large family but with no education and special training it is so difficult and she really struggles from week to week just trying to feed the family.
